XI'AN

located in central-northwest China, records the great changes of the country just like a living history book. Called Chang'an (meaning the eternal city) in ancient times, it is one of the birthplaces of the ancient Chinese civilization in the Yellow River Basin area. As the eastern terminal of the Silk Road and the site of the famous Terracotta Warriors of the Qin Dynasty, the city has won a reputation all over the world. More than 3,000 years of history including over 1,100 years as the capital city of ancient dynasties, have endowed the city with an amazing historical heritage. Visitors marvel at the numerous historical sites and cultural relics in and around the city.

DAY 10 | SHANGHAI-XI'AN

Upon arrival, your tour guide will meet you at the airport and start the tour.

Xi'an is one of the birthplaces of the ancient civilization. During Xian's 3,100 year development, 13 dynasties placed capitals here, just like a living history book. Xian enjoys equal fame with Athens, Cairo, and Rome as one of the four major ancient civilization capitals. Upon arrival we visit the **【Shaanxi Historical Museum】**, which is a grand complex of buildings imitating the architecture style of the Tang Dynasty (618-907). It is a comprehensive museum with more than 370,000 exhibits of different times and kinds.

Tonight, we will enjoy the special local imperial dumpling banquet dinner and magnificent **【Tang Dynasty Singing & Dancing Show】**.

DAY 11 | XI'AN (B,L,D)

After breakfast, we will visit **【Qin Emperor's Mausoleum】** and the **【Terra Cotta Warriors and Horses Museum】**, it is the most significant archeological excavations in 1974. Qin (d. 210 B.C.), the first unifier of China, is buried, surrounded by life-sized famous Terra Cotta Warriors, at the centre of a complex designed to mirror the urban plan of the capital. The Terra Cotta Army it rated as one of the top attractions in China; in 1987 it was enlisted in the UNESCO.

After the museum, we will continue to visit the **【Artistic Ceramics Factory】**, to learn about the techniques of



making Tan San Cai, as well as the Terra Cotta Warriors.

DAY 12 | FLY BACK TO HOME(B)
